The Uganda Humanist Schools Trust helps a number of schools in Uganda who are working to offer liberal, humanist education to needy children. Founded by Ugandan Humanists and run as charities, the schools are inclusive and do not discriminate on grounds of religion, social or ethnic background.

They are located in impoverished rural areas, where few families can pay for education and where many children, orphaned by disease, are cared for by extended family members. The Humanist Schools are first and foremost a humanitarian response to the desperate need to provide educational opportunities for such children. However, they are also part of a pioneering experiment to create schools in Africa with a liberal, humanist ethos. As one school principal explains: *“Every child in this school is treated as a human being. If one person is hungry it is a problem for us all. We take care of each other. We apply reason and science to solve our problems and we challenge superstition and prejudice.”*

The schools were started on a shoestring using local resources and with community support. Facilities are poor but improving thanks to support from members of the British Humanist Association, the Rationalist Association/New Humanist, the International Humanist and Ethical Union, and the work of Uganda Humanist Schools Trust.
